






WHAT IS A MULTI-SITE TEAM?

- Multi-site teams participate in 2 or more run site locations with 10 or more people in each location.
- Multi-site teams can register in one of the four team categories: Corporate, Friends & Family, Women, or School.
- A Multi-Site Team Coordinator is the main contact and oversees all teams. Each local team will also designate a Team Captain. The Multi-Site Team Coordinator can also act as Team Captain for their local run site.




